

# DESTINATION KAUA'I

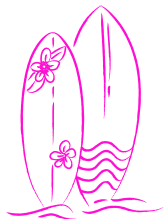
Here is some information to get you started on planning your vacation.

Recreational items should be used properly and at your own risk. If you notice an item that is not operating as it should be, please contact the Property Manager so that we may be able to replace it for you.

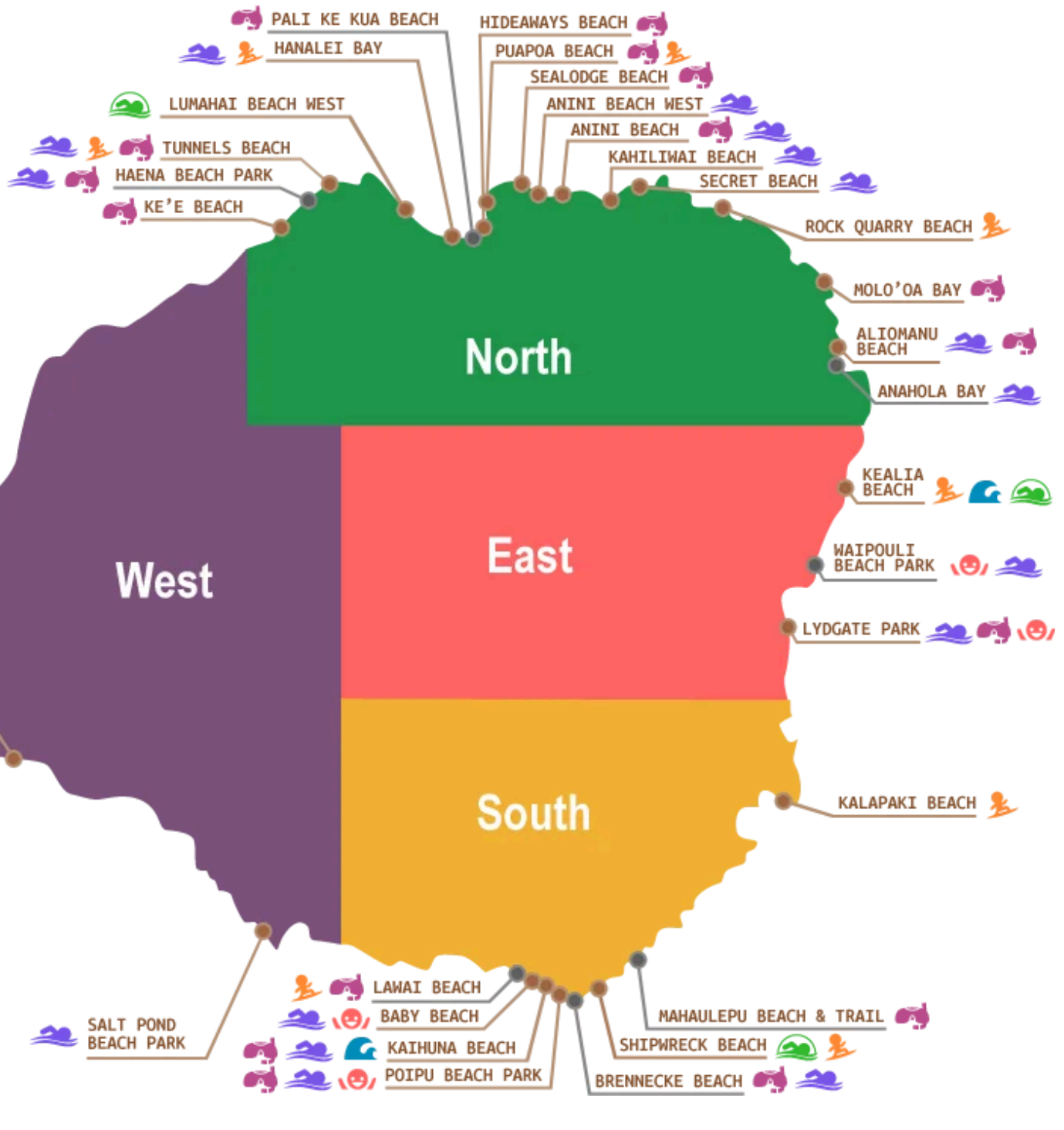
We provide beach chairs, beach umbrella, and a beach cooler for your use. Some ground floor properties may also have a beach wagon available.

Swimming, surfing, paddleboarding, picnics. Home to world famous Hanalei Pier: originally built in 1892 to serve the rice industry of the early 1900s. Featured in countless movie from the 1950s-present, including films such as South Pacific and The Decendants.

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## Tunnels Beach / Ha'ena State Park / Ke'e Beach

Snorkeling, Swimming, sightseeing, sunbathing. Home to the trailhead of world-famous Kalalau Trail (11 miles). Non-residents are required to book a reservation 30 days in advance. Plan accordingly. Visit [gohaena.com](http://gohaena.com) to book your reservation. \$5 entry / \$10 parking.

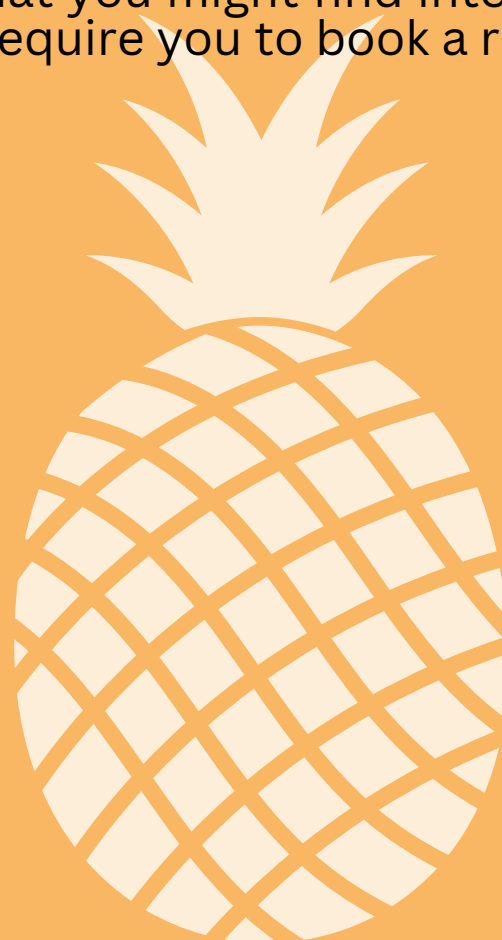

# Weather Advisories

As a precaution, the County of Kaua'i Emergency Management Agency performs a monthly siren test on the first day of every month.

As you know, Kaua'i is a beautiful place. It is also home to the wettest spot on earth: Mount Wai'ale'ale, averaging 450 inches of rain per year.

When visiting our tropical climate, you may experience changes in humidity and inclement weather, which can be expected or occur suddenly.

If heavy rains occur, please ensure that windows are closed to prevent unexpected moisture from entering the unit.

If heavy winds occur, please ensure that loose items on lanais and patios are secured.

If in the unlikely event of an emergency weather warning, the Kaua'i Emergency Management Agency will post open Hurricane & Tsunami evacuation shelters at:
